Our club has a long-standing tradition dating back to the early 1960s by entering the Para Districts Cricket Association. At our peak, we fielded 3 Senior, 2 Junior and 1 Women's team, enjoying significant success, especially in the 1990s. Including three consecutive premierships, highlighted by a Grade 1 Premiership in the 1996/97 Season captained by Alan Wallwork.



After a 7-year hiatus, the club was reformed by former players who had been involved with the club for over 30 years. They were joined by new, enthusiastic individuals who played an important role in rebuilding the club from the ground up. This collaborative effort has transformed us into a highly successful and family-oriented team.

We hold ambitious aspirations for the future. Since our reformation, we've achieved remarkable success, with exceptional talents who have transitioned from our juniors to our senior formats. We've consistently reached the finals across various senior grades. In 2021/22 our A2 team clinched the premiership, our victory coincided with the installation of our new natural turf pitches. In the 2023/24, all three of our season teams made the finals, with the A4 and A5 teams reaching the grand final and the A5 team winning the premiership.

The foundation of Willaston Cricket Club is a community of family-orientated people dedicated to shared success and the enjoyment of cricket. We train hard and play fair, upholding the true spirit of the sport. The Donnybrook ethos instills courage, teamwork, and selflessness, values we pride ourselves on.
