OUR HERITAGE, OUR CLUB

Our club has a long-standing tradition dating back to the early 1960s by entering the Para Districts Cricket Association. At our peak, we fielded 3 Senior, 2 Junior and 1 Women's team, enjoying significant success, especially in the 1990s. Including three consecutive premierships, highlighted by a Grade 1 Premiership in the 1996/97 Season captained by Alan Wallwork.





After a 7-year hiatus, the club was reformed by former players joined by new, enthusiastic individuals who helped rebuild the club from the ground up. This effort transformed us into a successful, family-oriented team. Since reforming, we've seen consistent growth, with juniors professing into senior ranks and regular finals appearances. In 2021/22 our A2 team won the premiership, coinciding with the installation of our new turf pitches. In 2023/24, all three senior teams made finals, with A4 and A5 reaching grand finals and A5 claiming the premiership.

The Willaston Cricket Club is built on community and shared successes. We train hard, play fair, and uphold the spirit of the sport. The Donnybrook ethos instills courage, teamwork, and selflessness, values we pride ourselves on.

Our junior program has welcomed families, offering access to our club and introducing cricket through the Woolworths Cricket Blast. We aim to grow our young players into confident, committed athletes ready for higher levels. A highlight was our Under 13s going undefeated and winning the 2022/23 premiership, followed by a back to back title in 2023/24.

In 2024/25, we fielded A2 and A3 teams, with the A3s reaching the grand final. Our junior teams included Rookies, Under 10s, Under 12s (combined with Long Plains), and Under 16s. The Under 12s made the finals and the Under 16s reached the grand final, continuing our strong presence across all levels.
